

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE, INDIANA,  
PROHIBITING THE ABANDONMENT OF ICE BOXES,  
REFRIGERATORS AND CONTAINERS HAVING AIR-TIGHT  
DOORS.

Be it and it hereby is ordained by the Common Council of the City of Portage, Indiana, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave outside of any building or dwelling, in a place accessible to children, any abandoned, unattended or discarded ice box or refrigerator or any other container of any kind which cannot be opened by a device on the inside of said ice box, refrigerator or container.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave outside of any building or dwelling, in a place accessible to children, unattended or discarded, any ice box or refrigerator or other container of any kind which has an air-tight snap lock or other such device thereon, without first removing the said snap lock or device or doors from said ice box, refrigerator or container.

3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Three Dollars (\$3.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00). Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

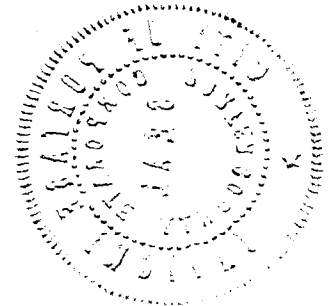

## Ordinance No. 68-10

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE, INDIANA, PROHIBITING THE ABANDONMENT OF ICE BOXES, REFRIGERATORS AND CONTAINERS HAVING AIR-TIGHT DOORS**

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Three Dollars (\$3.00) nor more than Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00).
