ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PORTAGE FORBIDDING
OPEN AND UNATTENDED FIRES AND PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT, AND IT HEREBY IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF PORTAGE:

SECTION 1. When used in this Ordinance, an "open fire" is any fire which is not enclosed within the confines of a furnace, stove, fireplace, or other structure of solid wall construction, the confines of which, or the chimney of which extend above the upper limit of the flames created in said fire.

SECTION 2. When used in this ordinance, the term "unattended fire" shall be any fire not supervised and watched by a person who is at such time within fifty (50) feet thereof.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any firm, person or corporation who starts a fire or allows or directs the same to be started, to leave the same open and unattended so long as the same is burning, or any sparks remain in the ashes thereof.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating or failing to comply with any provisions for this ordinance shall be fined not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar, nor more than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, according to law.

BE IT, AND IT HEREBY IS OBTAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

OF THE TOWN OF PORTAGE:

SECTION 1.
