

**ORDINANCE NO. 22-24**

**ORDINANCE RECERTIFYING COUNCIL DISTRICTS**

**WHEREAS**, under Indiana Code, a City Council of an Indiana City must consider whether to redistrict the Council districts within their city every ten (10) years, (following the decennial US Census), and


**WHEREAS**, 2022 is such a redistricting year, and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Indiana Code, the Common Council of the City of Portage Indiana has analyzed and considered whether a redistricting of the council districts is necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Portage Common Council:

1. That the Common Council of the City of Portage Indiana hereby recertifies that their existing districts are compact, contiguous, and as nearly equal in population as possible, and
2. That for the reasons heretofore stated, no redistricting of the current council districts is required.
